

a 125-acre site





## Background

- The International Summer Programme (ISS) was started in the University of Nottingham Malaysia in 2011.
- ISS is currently under the umbrella of the Faculty of Arts and Social Science and International Office of the University of Nottingham Malaysia Campus.
- ISS has participants from 20 different countries. In 2017, we had participants from UK, Japan, US, France, Taiwan, China, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Kazakhstan and Australia.

- Offered at the Universities to **Undergraduates, Postgraduates** and also **Academics**
- Age limit is 18 yrs and over
- English proficiency is a must! IELTS 6 or \*Other English Language certificates
- Fee Structure :
  - Developing Nations - **RM2500**
  - Non Developing Nations - RM4750
  - Partner Universities/UNUK/UNNC - RM3750
- Participants are entitled for a 10% early bird discount if the full fee is made by 30 April 2018.
- *Group Discounts available – 10 students + 1 complimentary)*
- A team of current Nottingham Malaysia students act as students helpers/ambassadors throughout the duration of the Summer School.
- Deadline for Application – 1 June 2018




